

Clarinet:

- Normal tone-realization with forcefully "slapping" the keys notated in order to achieve a perceptible percussive effect.
- Key clicks/slaps: unpitched rustling; with individual choice of keys, that should be
 most suitable for the specific instrument (free choice of keys only for those notes
 above the stave, i.e. notated g" etc.. Other key clicks/slaps should be performed as
 notated.)
